Thank you for your interest in this Brow Masterclass Course!

This introduction to eyebrow permanent makeup (PMU) course is a 3-day *intensive* in-person training with a weekend break in between to digest what you are learning and practice.

Course includes:

- Microblading
- Manual Shading

In addition, it will also give you the foundations you need to keep adding on other permanent makeup services in the future.

COST:

\$2500 CAD per student.

\$500 non-refundable deposit is required to sign up. You will receive your extensive manual (one of the largest available!) to start studying your new craft within 4 weeks of the deposit being paid.

The Remaining amount is due prior to the start of your training date (TBD based on student preferences) and can be paid via cash (due the morning of class start), credit card through my website, or a payment plan can be arranged. A payment plan can also be arranged through Brittany's studio, The Beauty Block.

*Please note, if the amount is not paid in full by the first morning of the class, you will not be able to attend any portion of the training.

As part of your training, you will receive a large kit with everything you need to get started valued at over \$500 CAD!
